Simply sort your recyclables into the two categories below, put them in a green bin (or any other open-top container), and out with your trash. Use the handy reference calendar on the reverse side to track the weeks.

It's that simple!

Recyclables are divided into 2 categories: **Category 1 (Mixed Paper)** and **Category 2 (Commingled Containers)**, and will be picked up on an alternating week schedule. Refer to the calendar on the reverse side denoting whether it's a **Mixed Paper week** or a **Commingled Containers week**.

Category 1: Mixed Paper "Green weeks"

"If you can rip it, RECYCLE it!"

Corrugated Cardboard: boxes, brown paper bags, clean pizza & cereal boxes

Mixed paper: all office paper, junk mail, newspapers, flyers, magazines, envelopes, paperback books, phone books, stapled & clipped paper, brochures

Pressboard

Category 2: Commingled Containers

"Burgundy weeks"

"It usually comes from your pantry!"

All returnables: plastic and glass bottles

#1 through #7 plastic containers: (please, **NO** plastic bags or cat litter containers!)

Glass: clear, brown, and green containers **ONLY!**

Steel & tin cans

Aluminum cans & foil
